

The Lake District in North West England is a mountainous region approximately 1 000 meters above sea level which features many lakes. As one of Britain's most popular tourist destinations, it is said to be as picturesque as a painting. During glacial regression, glaciers carved out the soil, creating valleys in which water pooled and formed lakes of various sizes. Recognized for its untouched nature and as a cultural landscape promoting various human activities such as sheep-herding, the Lake District was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2017. Author of world-famous Peter Rabbit, Beatrix Potter, took up residence in this area, and her picture books reflect the surrounding scenery with thorough faithfulness.
